Parental Supervision Policy

It is the policy of Tribe FM that a parent/guardian is present at training, during studio, and outside broadcast events to supervise their own children. A child is defined as a person under the age of 18 years on the day. Being present requires the parent/guardian to be in the same room or in line of sight of their child. This is a similar requirement as used in South Australian schools.

This is to ensure that:

- Children are to be supervised by a parent/guardian when visiting toilet facilities at the studio or outside broadcast venues.
- Any discipline issues that arise can be addressed on the spot with the child and, if needed, by the parent/guardian.
- Parents/guardians can respond immediately if any urgent medical attention is required for their child in the case of injury or illness.
- Children are not left waiting at the station or outside broadcast event to be picked up after a show or event.

The role of the Training Persons / Managers are to provide supervision and direction of the children in the immediate context of the actual studio training or outside broadcast session. It is not realistic nor reasonable to expect Tribe FM volunteers and managers to provide additional supervision duties such as those listed above.

If due to personal circumstances, parents/guardians are unable to remain at the studio for training and/or shows or outside broadcast events, then it is the parents/guardians responsibility to:

- Arrange for another parent/guardian to supervise your child in your absence.
- Inform the Station Manager and/or Training Manager which alternate person will be supervising your child in your absence.
- Ensure that Tribe FM have the correct contacts details for both parents/guardians in the case of emergencies.
- Tribe FM will only have contact details of the one parent/guardian which has been supplied on the membership form. Families should provide additional contact details as appropriate to the Station Managers who can update the Station's contact list.

Children's safety and well-being is a primary concern for Tribe FM and our expectation is for all parents/guardians to support this supervision policy.
